Nov. 20: Player Development Camp

Nov. 21 and 22: Territorial Trials

-WEATHER DEPENDENT-

Selection Criteria:

- A. Aggregate results of the Sprint and Individual Race.
If the weather allows for only one race, the results of the one race will be the basis for the team selection.
- B. Attitude and Commitment
- C. Race Distance: AWG race distances to be used; may be shortened by jury, conditions dependent.
- D. Events: Individual and Sprint
- E. Firearms familiarity –anyone not being able to demonstrate total competence in the safe handling of firearms will not be allowed to participate in the trials.
- F. Any athlete not dressed to promote personal safety with regard to climatic conditions will be removed from the race.
- G. Equipment: Provision of all equipment e.g. snowshoe/skiing gear, firearms, ammo, etc. are the responsibility of the individual athlete.

Jr. Male and Female –born in 1992/93/94

Juvenile Male and Female –born in 1995 or later.
