## **OFFICIALS**

Host Societies are responsible for providing the proper level of certified sport officials for the Arctic Winter Games. The following is a summary of the minimum certification levels required:

<b>Alpine Skiing</b>	Technical Director appointed by sanctioning authority Level 2 Timers Level 1 Gate Keepers
<b>Badminton</b>	Canada – Regional Level Alaska – State Level Greenland – National Level
<b>Basketball</b>	Canada / Territorial – minimum 80% mark on written exam administered by Territorial Sport Governing Body plus experience officiating at Territorial Basketball Championships  Canada / Alberta – High School officials (3A or 4A experience)  Alaska – TBD  Three officials per Game
<b>Biathlon - Ski &amp; Snowshoe</b>	Competition Chief Level 2 Other Chiefs Level 1

<b>Cross Country Skiing</b>	Technical Director appointed by sanctioning authority  Level 2 with experience <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Chief of Stadium</li><li>• Chief of Course</li><li>• Chief of Timing</li><li>• Chief of Manual Results</li><li>• Chief of Security</li></ul> Level 1 with experience <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Volunteers</li><li>• Communications</li><li>• Equipment</li><li>• Finance</li><li>• Venue Services</li></ul>
<b>Curling</b>	Head Official Level 3 (or Level 2 with approved experience) Other on ice officials Level 2
<b>Dene Games</b>	Consult with the participating Units to select a suitable Head Officials and up to three Judges
<b>Dog Mushing</b>	Consult with the participating Units to select suitable Officials
<b>Figure Skating</b>	Senior Evaluator Level (3 to 5 Judges)
<b>Freestyle Skiing</b>	As required by the rules of the sport
<b>Gymnastics</b>	First year Provincial 2 or higher (8 in total) – the practice has been to use 2 panels of 4 judges for two events being run simultaneously.
<b>Hockey</b>	Level 3 and 18 years of age All insured by appropriate hockey association

<b>Indoor Soccer</b>	Canada – Class 3 Canadian Soccer Association Alaska – Level 6 United States Soccer Federation Greenland – National Level  All officials must have indoor soccer officiating experience.
<b>Arctic Sports</b>	Consult with the participating Units to select a suitable Head Officials and up to three Judges
<b>Snowboarding</b>	Level 1 & 2
<b>Snowshoeing</b>	Consult with the participating Units to select suitable Officials
<b>Speed Skating</b>	Referee – Level 3 Chiefs – Level 2 Assistants – Level 1
<b>Table Tennis</b>	Technical Director – National Level (Canada) Other Umpires – Provincial Level (Canada)
<b>Volleyball</b>	Regional Level
<b>Wrestling</b>	National Level C Recommend a minimum of 5 officials
